

- » **VERY IMPORTANT:** Make sure you keep your baggage claim slips that are given to you when checking your bags - you may need to present these to a security officer at the Port-au-Prince airport. Also you may need about \$6-\$10 in one dollar bills for tipping at the airport. It would also be good to have another \$10 in ones as extra.
- » The airport has 4 steps; it's not difficult, just tricky because not many people speak English. GP personnel already in the country are not permitted inside this part of the airport to receive guests, so you will have to navigate this on your own.
  1. While on the plane you will be given 2 forms to fill out. One is a green visa that asks for name, date of birth, address, passport number, airline flight number, etc. Make certain you fill out both the top and bottom of the green form and sign both the top and bottom. It will also ask for the address of where you will be staying in Haiti – enter: 61 # 7, Tabarre. The other form is a white customs form. Just fill it out and sign. You will have nothing to declare since you are coming as a visitor. One of the flight attendants can help you if needed.
  2. When you get off the plane, you will either walk or be bused to a separate building depending on the particular airline. Lines will form to proceed through immigration. Baggage will be arranged in a cordoned off area awaiting pickup.
  3. As you are exiting the building with your bags, you will proceed through customs, which is very perfunctory.
  4. The team leader should make sure that the GP missionary or driver is seen prior to anyone leaving the building. The GP team will be wearing beige vests with the GP logo on them. There are porters outside the building desiring to help you with luggage. You may want to use one. If choosing to use one or several please be prepared to pay \$1 per bag.
- » In an emergency, borrow a cell phone from someone close by (you will want to give them a couple of dollars for this) and call one of the following numbers:
